

Medication in Schools



Any medications sent in to school need to be clearly labelled with the child's name and class. We are unable to administer medication to your child and so we ask that you make the necessary arrangements when this is needed.

Should your child frequently complain of minor ailments, we will notify you so that you can consult your GP.

If your child suffers a minor cut or graze at school, we may (by law) only wash and clean the wound and cover it with a dressing. Please ensure that you check the wound when your child comes home. A note will be sent home with your child explaining what action was taken. Serious cuts would mean that we would immediately contact a parent.

Could we please ask that if your child has an allergy and has been prescribed an EpiPen, could we please have two brought into school. One of these needs to be in the classroom at all times and one in the medical room so it is accessible if the child is out of class. All children who have been prescribed inhalers need to have one in school at all times.

Four members of our staff are now fully trained in the administration of first aid.
